

04 - 10 ZAH ZUH ZAZ EVENINGS

Inspired by 78rpm gramophone records of the 1930s and 1940s, this rhythm drenched quartet pays homage to legends of the past, including Cab Calloway, Slim Gaillard and Fats Waller, transporting you to the heady days of late-night clubs and the golden age of jazz.

09-10 JOPLIN PARNELL FROM 12:30PM

Rooted in the classic styles and genres popular between 1900 and 1940, this lively trio mixes rich turn-of-the-century European musical traditions with American Blues and driving Swing rhythms. Expect forgotten songs and new ways to interpret the timeless music composed in the first half of the 20th century.

DEC GABRIELLE DUCOMBLE EVENINGS

An established favourite in her adopted UK, Belgian-born Gabrielle brings a special blend of European charm and sophistication to her performance of Parisian-style jazz, toe-tapping swing, chansons and vintage melodies. Expect sass, jazz and old-school glamour.





16 - 17 DEC CAROLINE LOFTUS FROM 12.30PM

Channelling the spirit of the Great Gatsby era, Caroline Loftus and her Bellbird Boys deliver rapturous music from the roaring 20s and crazy 30s. Charming melodies, romance, hot jazz and foot-stomping rhythm.

18 - 24 DEC BEZIQUE evenings

Jazz cellist Shirley Smart leads a band performing acoustic jazz and café music from around the world. A uniquely cosmopolitan sound on the UK acoustic jazz scene, the band's repertoire includes music by Django Reinhardt, Richard Galliano, Bireli Lagrene and others, as well as original compositions.

23 DEC LONDON DJANGO COLLECTIVE FROM 12:30PM

Remaining in the spirit of Django, whilst pushing the genre of gypsy jazz forward into the vibrant London jazz scene, the London Django Collective have a vision of true progression for the style whilst nodding to the great musicians who came before them.

BO-BIDEC OLLY MUXWORTHY TRIO FROM 12:30PM

With a warm bass voice reminiscent of Johnny Hartman and an enchanting playing style, jazz singer and pianist Olly Muxworthy's captivating performances have made him a beloved figure amongst audiences in London. Olly specialises in the timeless classics of Nat King Cole, Frank Sinatra, and other gems from the Great American Songbook.



BAR AMÉRICAIN


AS TRANSATLANTIC TRAVEL GREW IN POPULARITY DURING THE EARLY 20TH CENTURY, MANY AMERICAN BARS BEGAN TO OPEN IN PARIS, SUCH AS 'LE GRAND DUC' IN MONTMARTRE.

> These Parisian hangouts became legendary throughout Europe – the kinds of places frequented by the likes of Ada Smith, Josephine Baker and Duke Ellington.

These spots were havens of cultural expression and exchange between Parisians and Americans, not to mention becoming the inspiration behind Bar Américain, our pocket of Americana within Parisian Zédel...

In the heart of Soho, yet hidden from view under the hustle and bustle of Piccadilly, Bar Américain is a truly authentic American Bar.

Classic and house cocktails are served nightly alongside a selection of wines, champagnes, beers and non-alcoholic options.


